



Coventry Cycle Speedway Club Code of Conduct for Parents and Carers 2021

As a parent or carer of a club member, you are expected to abide by the following code by:

- Informing the coach of any specific health requirements, medical conditions recent injuries of your young person in advance of the coaching session, by completing the information requested on the Parent or Carer Consent Form and keeping the club up to date should circumstances change
- Advising the coach if your young person has to leave early
- Remaining at the track at all times while your young person is either training or competing
- Encouraging your young person to learn the rules and play within them
- Discouraging unfair play and arguing with officials
- Helping your young person to recognise good performance, not just results
- Setting a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- Never punishing or humiliating a young person for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accepting officials' judgements and teaching young people to do likewise
- Supporting your young person's involvement and helping them enjoy their sport
- Using correct and appropriate language at all times
- Remembering that young people participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours
- Supporting all efforts to remove bullying, both verbal and physical from sporting activities
- Respecting the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, disability, cultural background, religion or ethnicity
- Showing appreciation and respect for coaches, officials and sport administrators. Remember, without these volunteers, your young person would not be able to participate
